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## Universal Hindu Parliment



- It has seven parts:
- **Chit sabha** - where Paramashiva does all the Pancha Krityas and He releases all information He wants to share with the world from Chit Sabha.
- **Deva Sabha** - Hinduism has a unique way of Gods directly landing on human beings' plane, on planet Earth, and do the administration.
- O Hindus! don't be apologetic / agnostic, when we say Paramashiva himself came as Irayanar, Sundaresa Pandiya, Chokkanatha Peruman and created the Pandya Samrajya and started ruling. Don't think it is mythology or story. It is not story, it is history.
- Gods do come to planet Earth.
- Paramashiva himself came and created Pandya Samrajya and ruled Madurai as Sundara Pandiyan, Chokkanatha Peruman, Irayanar.

## Universal Hindu Parliament



- Parashakti Herself came as Meenakshi.
- And Subrahmanya came as Ugra Pandiya. These are true.
- Deva Sabha - will be run by the Gods and Goddesses who have come directly from Paramashiva to planet Earth either in the form of Incarnations, like how Subrahmanya has come as Skanda Mata, or as partial bhava samadhi. Gods will land on sincere human beings either as partial or full incarnations. Those beings will form this Deva Sabha.
- Raja Sabha - will be formed by all the Hindus activists all over the world. if you are a Hindu Guru / Peetadhipathi / Matathipathi / Hindu party leader / Hindu political activist / Hindu social leader / any of the Hindu communities' leader like Brahmins, Devar, Shaiva Vellalar / Hindu yoga studios / Hindu temple priests, owners - anyone who runs any Hindu ecosystem, you are eligible to become Raja Sabha member of Kailasa - Universal Hindu Parliament!


## Universal Hindu Parliament





## Who is Paramashiva?

Paramaśiva is the primordial Divinity in Hinduism - the Ultimate Reality and Cause, which is self-effulgent (*svayamprakāśa*), all-pervading, unchanging beyond time, space, form and causality.


Agamas reveal that Bhagwan Paramashiva is unseparated with Sakti who is in the form of supreme consciousness and is eternally free from the limiting factors such as direction, space and time. Bhagwan Paramashiva exists as the perennial source, maintaining the evolutionary process of space of the great maya from the nature of auspiciousness and bliss.




## Paramashiva - The Supreme Ruler of the Universe

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## Paramashiva - The Supreme Ruler of the Universe



"The Sages: O, Lord, the possessor of six potential qualities (Bhagavan)! You are the governing Lord of the gods of lower realm and the higher realm. You are relieving the bound souls from the bonds which constrict them.

**You are performing the five cosmic actions- creation, maintenance, dissolution, concealment and bestowal of grace.** You are the one who directly maintains the evolutionary process of space and other categories issuing out of the great maya. Your form is of the nature of auspicious mass of bliss springing forth from within your own self and of the nature of your own pure consciousness. You are inseperaited with supreme Sakti who is in the form of supreme consciousness. You are eternally free from the limiting factors such as direction, space and time. Through your pervasive presence, You exist as the perennial source for the delighted state of the worlds. O, the Lord of all gods!, we have been directed by you to engage ourselves in the systematic worship of Siva. In order to perform that worship perfectly, be favorably disposed now to instruct the principles enshrined in the Scripture which is the quintessence of the Scriptures revealed from the faces of Lord Siva. O, the Lord of all gods!, you are with such a compassion which spontaneously flows towards your devotees. Be kind enough to instruct those principles."

## Paramashiva - The Supreme Ruler of the Universe

The **Kamika Agama Purva and Uttara Pada verses 6 to 9** describes Bhagwan Paramashiva as the possessor of **six cosmic capabilities**. Along with governing the three planes of existence - the heavenly planets or the higher realm, the earthly realm and the lower worlds, Bhagwan Paramashiva performs these **Five Cosmic actions of Creation, Maintenance, Rejuvenation, pulling out of Delusion and Liberation**.

In the Vedagamic tradition, the concept of God has more than just 3 functions or actions **GOD; G-Generation (creation), O-Operation (maintenance) & D-Destruction (rejuvenation)** as widely regarded in western traditions. In addition to these 3 functions, the ultimate supreme consciousness - Paramashiva also performs the actions of **Pulling out of Delusion and Liberation**. The collection of these **5 cosmic acts** is called **Pancha Kritya**.

## Pancha Kritya in Mrgendra Agama (verse. 3, chapter 2, Paramoksha Nirāsha Prakarnam)

**jagaj-janma-sthiti-dhvamsa tirobhāva vimuktayah |  
kṛtyam sakārakphalaṁ jñeyamasyaita deva hi ||**

Manifestation or emergence, jagaj-janma [shristi]; sustenance or continued existence, sthiti; adsorption or disappearance, dhvamsa, concealing or covering the Existence (existential reality) by secretly making it invisible and uncognizable (tirobhāva); the bestowal of grace which results in the ultimate liberation, vimuktayah – all these are the **5 actions, kṛtyam (of Sadashiva)**, who is associated with Shaktis which serve as His instruments and body and who is holding the fruits (in the form of enjoyment, bhogas and liberation, moksha). **These 5 actions are certainly being performed only by Him.**

## Pancha Kritya as explained in Mrigendra Agama

1. **Creation or Śristi** - the action or process of bringing into existence, also known as manifestation or emergence
2. **Maintenance or Sthiti** - the act of maintaining of someone or something in existence, also known as sustenance or preservation
3. **Rejuvenation or Samhāra** - the restoration of something, also known as destruction
4. **Delusion or Trobhāva** - is action of pulling out of delusion
5. **Liberation or Anugraha** - is the act of bestowing the realization of the Ultimate and becoming one with Him.



## Five Faces of Paramashiva

The 5 faces of Paramashiva, the ultimate supreme consciousness, are the manifest form and are called Ishvara or vyakta. Through this manifest side He performs these **five cosmic acts (Pancha Kriya)** of Manifestation, Maintenance, Rejuvenation, pulling out of Delusion and Liberation through His 5 faces:

1. **Sadyojata Face represents Śristi**  
(Creation or Manifestation)
2. **Vamadeva Face represents Sthiti**  
(sovereign rulership and maintenance or operation)
3. **Aghora Face represents Samhāra**  
(Rejuvenation or Destruction)
4. **Tatpurusha Face represents Trobhāva**  
(Pulling out of Delusion)
5. **Ishana Face represents Anugraha**  
(Liberation)



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## Five Faces of Paramashiva

Paramashiva, the ultimate supreme consciousness, has 6 faces, each of them perform one Pancha Kritya action. The Sixth face is the unmanifest face, where He resides in His supreme **Paramashiva Svarupa** as Ajomukha or Adhomukha - unborn (unmanifest - Avyakta), beyond form and formlessness.


That Paramashiva Svarupa state manifests the other five faces of **Paramashiva** and performs the Pancha Kritya (5 cosmic actions) through them.

Each face of Paramashiva expresses 5 phases, which is the permutation and combination of the Pancha Kritya.

The Sadyojata Face, that is the Face of creation has five phases -  
1. Creation of Manifestation  
2. Creation of Sustenance  
3. Creation of Rejuvenation  
4. Creation of Delusion  
and 5. Creation of Liberation

Similarly the other 4 faces of Paramashiva have 5 phases each, amounting to 25 faces of Paramashiva.







## Tattvas defined in Mrigendra Agama



## Tattvas defined in Mrigendra Agama

**Tattva is of the nature of an existence and also of the nature of revealing its own attributes.** The existence of Saktis in this Isvara Tattva need not be considered to be a different Tattva, since these Saktis are there assisting in the cosmic functions being carried out by the Vidyasvaras and others who are in this Tattva. **That which does not sustain any modification even when it is involved in various activities and which is firm in its own innate state, is known as Sakti.** All the creations are within its control. **That which is under the control and direction of a different existence is known as Tattva,** this definition is applicable to the entire range of Tattvas.

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## What are Tattvas?


*"I will use the sanskrit word "tattva" – "experiential expression". "tat" "tva" – "the truth" "you". The truth told to you through experiential expression, the equivalent word in sanskrit is "tattva". Before even any identity or desire, fear of 'individual', developing in my system, my gurus made me realise i am a principle - tattva!"*

*"All the 36 tattvas are my own extension including your perception, ability to experience, possibilities and everything said and unsaid through these words. Your mind cannot go beyond these 36 tattvas. Everything known to your mind is in these 36 tattvas, even the idea of good, bad, right, and wrong inserted by the exploiting unconscious human society is within these 36 tattvas."*

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## What are Tattvas?


*“Once you become conscious of your existence, and that these 36 tattvas are paramashiva’s expression, you will simply be able to unclutch and just know what are the 36 tattvas which you should focus on and you will never allow addiction as part of your life.”*

*“If you understand that these 36 tattvas - shiva tattva, shakti tattva, sadashiva tattva, ishwara tattva, shuddhadvaita tattva, maya tattva, kala tattva, vidya tattva, buddhi tattva, ahankara tattva, prakriti tattva, pancha jnanedriyas, pancha karmendriyas, raga tattva, purusha tattva, prakriti tattva, manasa tattva, pancha tanmatras, pancha maha bhootas are the science of manifesting the superconsciousness of Paramashiva, then you will manifest the science of Paramashiva.”*

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

## What are Tattvas?

*“Purana-centric, understanding about life, will give you the realisation that 36 tattvas are manifestation of paramashiva and knowing them will make your consciousness mature and will addict you to the right things. You will be more and more addicted to being in samadhi. In these 36 tattvas, the highest is shiva tattva, the lowest is pancha maha bhutas. The source of this pancha bhutas: earth, water, air, fire, space, is pancha maha bhuta.”*

*“I am talking about the parliamentary structure of Kailasa, as part of that, i am explaining the 36 tattvas. People need to know these 36 tattvas and manifest the state, space, powers of paramashiva to become part of the Kailasa government, the parliament of Kailasa.”*

## What are Tattvas?

*“I am explaining the 36 Tattvas - Shiva Tattva, Shakti Tattva, Sadashiva Tattva. Anyone who understands these becomes qualified to be part of the Hindu governance, Hindu parliament, Hindu democracy. Hindu democracy is a responsible democracy. People who are educated in that field, introduced to that field, involved in that field, can only vote. So today I am declaring, everyone who is initiated by me, whether you are still a follower or not, you are authorised and you have a right to vote in Hindu democracy of Kailasa, because initiation cannot be killed.”*

## Paramashiva and His Cosmic Governance

Paramashiva governed the cosmos through His Avaranas . The entire maya matrix was governed by these avaranas. Each of the Avaranas are empowered with state, space, powers and superconsciousness of Paramashiva. Each avarana is established at specific tatvas. Based on their spiritual strength, they evolved through governance structure and assumed more responsibilities

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
## Cosmic Governance of Pancha Kritya through Avarana (cosmic sovereign order)

- 1) **Mantreshwaras** - dissolved in Him as mantras
- 2) **Vidhyeshwaras**- Initiated into Ishwara Tatva
- 3) **Ganeshwaras** - Operate with Maya Tattva - Illusion, Kaala Tattva - Time, Niyati Tattva - Casualty, Vidya Tattva- Knowledge, Raaga Tattva - Desire, Kalaa Tattva - Power
- 4) **Lokeshwaras** - Operate with Purusha Tattva, Prakriti Tattva, Buddhi Tattva - Intuition / Intelligence, Manas Tattva- Mind, Ahamkaara Tattva - Ego
- 5) **Astreshwaras**- Operate with 5 Jnanendrias, 5 Karmendrias, 5 Tanmantras and 5 Mahabhutas



## KAILASA's Governance : Cosmic Governance of Pancha Kritya through Avarana

- 1) **Mantreshwaras** - Govern Nithyananda Sabha  
(House of Supremes)
- 2) **Vidhyeshwaras**- Govern Deva Sabha  
(House of Cosmocrats)
- 3) **Ganeshwaras** - Govern Raja Sabha  
(House of Lords)
- 4) **Lokeshwaras** - Govern Kanaka Sabha  
(House of Prosperity)
- 5) **Astreshwaras**- Govern Chit Sabha  
(House of consciousness)

## Avaranas in Kamika Agama

In this body which has well expanded now, he should design a lotus-seat which is of the nature of Sakti. Having ideated the presence of the form of Vidya Deha of the Lord, he should invoke Lord Siva to occupy that form. On the pericarp of the lotus-seat, **he should worship Lord Siva as surrounded by the Brahma Mantras and Anga Mantras, Vidyasvaras, Ganas, Lokapalas and Ayudhas (weapons)**. Here, Lord Siva may be worshipped as surrounded of three enclosures, one Avarana or twenty-seven Avaranas according to capacity of the Sadhaka.

The avarana of Vidyeshvaras, the avarana of Ganesvaras, the avarana of Lokapalas, the avarana of Ayudhas, the avarana of the Rudras and other Lords – when these avaranas are worshipped, the sadhaka should breath out at the end of the worship of each avarana. Before commencing the worship of next avarana, he should breath out again. This should be repeated for each avarana.



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## Mantreshvaras in Mrigendra Agama

Among the **seventy millions of Mantras (Mantra Murtis)**, the Mantras belonging to the **later half** (numbering to thirty-five millions), depending on and **occupying the body of the Gurus, wield their authority of bestowing grace upon the befitting souls existing in the entire range of impure maya.**

Having fulfilled their designated function (as guided by Sivasakti), **they enter into the state of with Mantresvaras, at the time of the dissolution of the worlds of impure maya.**

Those Mantras who belong to the first half (numbering to thirty-five millions), without depending on or seeking any support or location such as the Guru's body and others, wield their authority of bestowing grace upon the befitting souls existing in the plane of impure maya which is just below the plane of pure maya. They bestow grace as willed and guided by Lord Siva. **Having fulfilled their function assigned to them according to the will of the Lord, they attain the supreme state of Siva, at the dissolution of their own plane of existence.**

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
## Mantreshvaras : Overview

1. Mantreshvaras form the first tier of the cosmic sovereign order (Avaranas)
2. Mantras or Mantra Murtis are seventy million in number and exist as part of Paramashiva as the five Mantras.
3. They operate within the state of Swarupya and Sayujya Mukti.
4. The **first** 35 million, fulfill their duty of liberating the befitting souls existing in the plane of impure maya which is just below the plane of pure maya.



## Mantreshvaras : Overview

5. They bestow grace as willed and guided by Lord Siva, **without depending** on or seeking any support or location such as the Guru's body and others.
6. The **later half** of 35 million perform the same action while **depending on and occupying the body of the Gurus**.
7. **As a part of their function in Earthly Government;** They are ministers (mantris) who counsel or personally present information to Paramashiva.

According to the gradation of the mature state of ‘Adhikara Mala’, these eight Vidyeshvaras are installed in a graded state in the Isvara Tattva.**

## Vidyeshvara : Overview

- They are inherently free from the bonds of karma and maya and are fit enough to be stationed in the plane of Lord Siva. The Supreme Lord installs 8 Vidyeshvaras – Ananta (highest state), Sukshma, Sivottama, Ekanetra, Ekarudra, Trimurti, Srikantha and Sikhandi (lowest state) - in Ishvara tattva.
- He associated these Vidyeshvaras with Vama, Jyestha and other Saktis and appoints seventy million Mantreshvaras as their group of advisors along with 1000 Rudras (118 of them being Maya-garbhadiharins i.e. chief amongst Rudras)
- The Rudras are Endowed with Shakti which observes the nature of the karmic bond of the souls and their bodies are designed with Kala and other Tattvas which evolve from knot of impure maya.



- These Vidyasvaras are the Lords wielding their authority over the Rajarajesvaras such as Satarudras and others, Rajesvaras such as Indra and others and Isvaras such as Mandali and others.



## 5 Shuddha Tattvas : Paramashiva Tattva

1. **Shiva Tattva or Paramashiva Tattva** - the living existence in every being - **I am Paramashiva**. In Shiva Tattva, the Absolute doesn't consist of any desire (icchā), action (kriyā) or Knowledge (jnāna) related properties. **It is in its pure conscious state.**

*“The moment you start cognising that (Paramashiva Tattva) as the core component of ‘Nithya’ in you, tonnes of problems become irrelevant! Especially when you start talking to Paramashiva day-in and day-out, it will bring so much of completion.*

*Paramashiva will appear in you as the inner Guru, Atma Guru, and constantly inspire and guide you. The outer Guru who appears to you in physical form will invoke the inner Guru in you. What you hear from your inner Guru you will hear me repeating in the satsang, and what I tell here in the satsang, you will hear the inner Guru repeating!”*

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## 5 Shuddha Tattvas : Shakti Tattva

2. **Shakti Tattva** : Once the infinite resource opens in a being, how much ever it gets involved with the world the world only strengthens the being and it's enlightenment.

*“For example: you come to planet earth with 100 unit energy. If you use that 100 unit energy to unclutch completely, your consciousness becomes intensely mature and fully enlightened. You open the infinite resource inside you. **Once you open the infinite resource, how much ever you get involved with the world the world only strengthens you and your enlightenment. This is called Shakti Tattva. Nature, prakriti, only strengthens your enlightenment.** But the first 100 unit energy you have, if you don't use for unclutching and open the infinite resource and before that, get directly involved with the outer world, the mess you will make for yourself in the outer world and in multiple levels, not only you will lose the outer world, you won't have even the inner world, the consciousness.”*



3. **Sadashiva Tattva** : Knowing Panch Kritis (creation, maintenance, destruction, delusion, liberation) are your dimensions.

Assimilating and understanding that death or delusion is not forced on you but is an extension of you which you forgot as your own manifestation, empowers you!”*

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

4. **Ishvara Tattva** : The space where the being meets it's Paramashivatva. Tapas makes the being manifest Ishwara Tattva.

***"Ishwara tattva is a space where you and me, you and paramashiva meet! You need to have an introduction to tapas. Tapas means not just breaking restrictive patterns, not just breaking restrictive mental setup, not just breaking restrictive logic, but breaking the restrictive consciousness itself. Example: if you have spontaneous lying as a restricting pattern for your integrity, deciding to go on silence is Tapas! Tapas is not just sitting and completing, but absolute silence until we realise how to be true, integrated to the consciousness! That is tapas!"***



5. **Suddha Vidya Tattva** : In Śuddhavidyā tattva Jnānaśakti is more initiative than kriyaśakti. Here, "self-ness" and "this-ness" become balanced. The other three acts of Panchakritya - creation, maintenance and destruction are done below Suddhavidya.





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## Overview of The 5 Shuddha Tattvas

Vidyasvaras are initiated and operate from the first 5 shuddha/pure tattvas of the 36, namely Shiva Tattva, Shakti Tattva, Sadashiva Tattva, Ishvara Tattva and Suddha Vidya Tattva.


1. **Shiva Tattva** is the state of non-desire (icchā), non-action (kriyā) and no-Knowledge (jnāna). It is the purest state of consciousness. It is the living existence in every being - 'I am Paramashiva'.
2. **Shakti Tattva**, Nature or Prakriti is the untapped infinite resource inside you, once the infinite potential opens in you and you get involved with the world, the world only strengthens you in your path to enlightenment.





## Overview of The 5 Shuddha Tattvas

3. **Sadashiva Tattva** is the state of Knowing Panch Kriyas (creation, maintenance, destruction, delusion, liberation) are your own dimensions. This state brings the understanding that Pancha Kriyas are an extension of your own manifestation exist only to empower you.
4. **Shvara Tattva** : The space where the being meets it's Paramashivatva. Intense tapas of breaking the restrictive consciousness pattern makes the being manifest Ishwara Tattva.
5. **Suddha Vidya Tattva** : In this state Jnānaśakti is more initiative than kriyaśakti. Here, "self-ness" and "this-ness" become balanced. The other three acts of Panchakriya - creation, maintenance and destruction are done below Suddhavidya.

**Specialities** : Each responsibility is executed, manifested by a set of Ganas and head of those ganas is Ganeshwara and head of all these ganas is Mahaganapati


**Mukti** : Sameepya Mukti

## Ganeshwara : Overview



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

8. **Niyati Tattva** - Casualty
9. **Vidya Tattva** - Knowledge
10. **Raaga Tattva** - Desire
11. **Kalaa Tattva** - Power




## 5 Shuddha-Ashuddha Tattvas : Maya Tattva

- (6) **Maya Tattva** - Illusion - **Maya** hides the divine nature of created beings as it creates the sense of separateness from the Divine and from each other.

*“The continuum of time and space is due to a stuff connecting both. That stuff is called **Maya Tattva** in Vedic tradition. **It is not there but it is there.** The time and space dimensions do not have a clear watertight compartment or border. For example: if time and space put together is 100 meters of cloth, then for some people it is 60 meter is time and 40 meter is space. For some people it is 30 meter is time and 70 meter is space. The time and space continuum and the way it exists as reality for you is not the way it exists as reality for others. That is why some people are so excited to wake up in the morning and some people feel, ‘O God, I don’t know why I need to open my eyes!’”*

### (7) **Kaala Tattva** - Principle of Kaala


(Greater Science of Time)

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, when the Self experiences a limited cognition of eternity (Nithyatva), it experience the phenomenon of time. The phenomenon of time divides all experience into past, present, and future. This aspect of Maya Tattva is called Kaala Tattva.

*“The fourth unit of time, when it is realised, liberates you from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Kala Tattva.”*

## 5 Shuddha-Ashuddha Tattvas : Niyati Tattva

(8) **Niyati Tattva** - the principle of causality  
(cause and effect)

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the self experiences a restricted or limited cognition of freedom, and thus it gives rise to karma (cause and effect), necessity, order. This aspect of Maya Tattva is called Niyati Tattva.

In ultimate reality, the Supreme Self is beyond all Niyati (karmas, cause and effect). Ultimate reality is, Paramashiva manifests the entire world in His own See.



## 5 Shuddha-Ashuddha Tattvas : Vidya Tattva and Raaga Tattva




(9) **Vidya Tattva** - the principle of limited knowledge.

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the all knowing self, experience itself as a limited-knower. The Self accords this limited knowledge with its present life experiences. When the Self realizes it's all-knowingness (Sarvajnanatva), it is beyond Vidya Tattva.

(10) **Raaga Tattva** - the principle of desire, attachment, Inclination.

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, when the Self, which is ultimately established in complete completion, experiences only a limited state of completion, it experiences desires for various objects. This aspect of Maya Tattva is called Raaga Tattva.

- (11) **Kalaa Tattva** - the principles of Kalaa (Higher science of art - Kalaa)  
[Kalaa - means infusing your Prana (life energy) into anything]

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the Self, which in ultimate reality is the All-Doer, experiences itself as a limited-Doer. This aspect of Maya Tattva is called Kalaa Tattva.

Kalaa Tattva draws the soul toward spiritual knowledge. Its energy partially removes the veil of Anava-mala (feeling of unworthiness) which clouds the inherent powers of the soul.

## Ganeshwara : Overview

Ganeshwaras are initiated and operate in 5 SHUDDHA - ASHUDDHA TATTVAS namely - Kaala Tattva (Time), Niyati Tattva - Casualty, Vidya Tattva- Knowledge, Raaga Tattva - Desire and Kalaa Tattva (Power) from the space of MAYA TATTVA - Illusion

### 6. Maya Tattva (Illusion)

Maya hides the divine nature of created beings as it creates the sense of separateness from the Divine and from each other. Time and Space forms a continuum due to this tattva. The time and space continuum and the way it exists as reality changes from one person to the other.

### 7. Kaala Tattva : Principle of Kaala (Greater Science of Time)

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the Self experiences a limited cognition of eternity (Nithyatva), hence experiencing the phenomenon of time. The phenomenon of time divides all experience into past, present, and future. When the fourth unit of time is realised, it liberates one from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Kala Tattva and moves beyond it.



## Ganeshwara : Overview

### 8. Niyati Tattva : the principle of casuality (cause and effect)

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the self experiences a restricted or limited cognition of freedom, and thus it gives rise to karma (cause and effect), necessity, order. In ultimate reality, the Supreme Self is beyond all Niyati (karmas, cause and effect). When the understanding of free will in its entirety is realised, it liberates one from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Niyati Tattva and moves beyond it.

### 9. Vidya Tattva : the principle of limited knowledge.

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the all knowing self, experience itself as a limited-knower. The Self accords this limited knowledge with its present life experiences. When the Self realizes it's all-knowingness (Sarvajnanatva), then it is liberated from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Vidya Tattva and moves beyond it.



## Ganeshwara : Overview

**10. Raaga Tattva** : the principle of desire, attachment, inclination.

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the Self experiences only a limited state of completion as it desires for various objects. When the Self realizes it is inherently and ultimately established in complete completion where no desire exists, then it is liberated from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Raaga Tattva and moves beyond it.

**11. Kalaa Tattva** : the principles of Kalaa (Higher science of art - Kalaa)

Under the influence of Maya Tatva, the Self, which in ultimate reality is the All-Doer, experiences itself as a limited-Doer. Kalaa means infusing your Prana (life energy) into anything, it draws the soul (Atma) toward spiritual knowledge. Its energy partially removes the veil of Anava-mala (feeling of unworthiness) which clouds the inherent powers of the soul. When the Self realizes this, then it is liberated from all the delusions and the sufferings caused due to the delusions related to the Kalaa Tattva and moves beyond it.



## 25 Ashuddha Tattvas : Buddhi Tattva, Manasa Tattva & Ahamkara Tattva



- (14) **Buddhi Tattva** - The principle of Buddhi (intellect, intuition). The ability to live life with the right (higher) context is called Buddhi.
- (15) **Manasa Tattva** - The principle of Manas (Mind). Manas, is the first step of our being. Manas analyses all perceived information completely and starts classifying. Manas is where the identification is made - "it is this" (itti itti). Manas processes perception and assigns it a singular word.
- (16) **Ahamkara Tattva** - The principle of Ahamkara (Ego). After Manas (Mind) has perceived, and assigned an experience a word. The ego will decide 'What is there for me,' based on ideas which we have been programmed into us from a young age.

- (16) **Ahamkara Tattva** - The principle of Ahamkara (Ego).  
That which decides ‘What is there for me,’ after manas has perceived is the sense of subjective selfhood - *Ahamkara* – that which interprets the activities of the three gunas in a way that understands the “I” as the agent or origin of an experience, i.e. “this is my experience.” From the Ahamkara springs the desire to experience the five sense-objects.



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

**18. Rasa Tattva** : Reflection of Jala (Water) Tattva in Manas (Mind), loosely translated as taste.

**19. Rupa Tattva** : Reflection of Tejas (Fire) Tattva in Manas (Mind), loosely translated as form.

**20. Sparsha Tattva** : Reflection of Vayu (Air) Tattva in Manas (Mind), loosely translated as touch.

**21. Shabhdha Tattva** : Reflection of Akasha (Ether) Tattva in Manas (Mind), loosely translated as sound.

## Astreshvaras : Overview

Astreshvaras are initiated and operate within 20 ASHUDDHA TATTVAS namely -

The 5 sense organs (**jñānendriya**) are the most *sattvic* functions of manas and include:

27. **ghrāna** (nose), i.e., principle of experiencing smell
28. **rasana** (tongue), i.e., principle of experiencing taste
29. **caksus** (eye), i.e., principle of experiencing sight
30. **tvāk** (skin), i.e., principle of experiencing touch
31. **śrotra** (ear), i.e., principle of experiencing sound

### For example:

Chaksu is the energy which is seeing through eyes. Eyes are just doors, openings. Chaksu converts all the signals into bio signals, then the file starts getting processed by Manas.



## Astreshvaras : Overview

The 5 motor organs (*karmendriya*), each corresponding to a sense organ, represent the physical organs of action. They are the most rajasic functions of manas.

**32. pāyu** (anus) - the intra-organ responsible for excretion

**33. upasthā** (sexual organ) - the intra-organ responsible for procreation

**34. pāda** (leg) - the intra-organ responsible for ambulation

**35. pāni** (hand) - the intra-organ responsible for grabbing and touching

**36. vāk** (mouth) - the intra-organ responsible for the words we utter

Intra-organ exists in the cross-section of body and mind, with no equivalent concept in the western physiology. As per Hinduism, body is not just a bio-mechanism but a kosha (sheath) of consciousness. Kosha means living independent intelligence.

## Types of Mukti

**Based on our involvement Paramashiva' government we attain Paramashiva Patham**

**1. Sālokya – living in the same world** - the realization that the entire vast universe of billions of galaxies and universes is all pervaded by the Divine Consciousness.

**2. Sārūpya – having the same form** - realization that every being is interconnected and all "apparently" separate jivas are embodiments of the One Divine Consciousness.

**3. Sāmīpya – being close to** - corresponding to the unconscious dreamless state of consciousness – realization of Paramashiva occurs when the nature of the Saguṇa Ívara is cognized and one surrenders to Him.


**4. Sāyujya – merging into** - corresponding to the Turiya the fourth state of consciousness. When this stage is achieved then the person becomes a complete Jivanmukta and gets the absolute freedom from rebirth and suffering –this is the final stage of Brahma-nirvāna.







# Section 4

Hindu Democracy -  
Janapada Polity in Vedic Era



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## Concept of Janapada (Hindu Democracy)



- The Janapada was a self-sustaining, political and cultural unit principled on sovereignty and independence, and fought for the same till the end. The people of Janapada were strongly attached to their ruler, their state, and all the peculiarities attached to it such as, dialect, its own form of government, customs, manners & its own god.
- When the religious practices and habits of the rulers got dominance over the language and religion of the subjects (if there ever existed a difference) a sort of synthesis ensued, which paved way for the unity of language and religion of that Janapada and hence it can be said that the unity of language and religion was not a cause but the effect of the Janapada formation.
- To earn honours and recognition in the Janapadas, one had to be well-versed in these peculiar arts and crafts of the realm.
- This was how the liberty of Janapada worked, a system which reaped maximum satisfaction of its people through developing a peculiar way of life. This view was the very cause of the brilliant and colossal contribution in the realm of philosophy, literature, polity, etc. the only major downside to this was its fissiparous tendencies that gave way to exclusiveness and isolation.
- Rigveda and Puranas like Ramayana and Mahabharata references successful implementation of Janapadas

## Evolution of Janapada

- The term Janapada is composed of 2 words: 'Jana' and 'Pada' and literally means the place of habitation of a particular pada or tribe.
- **In Ancient times, Janas** who were **mobile in their habitation** and well under the institution of democracy or Samiti, divided themselves into many families and formed territories as their **permanent homeland** called **Janapadas**.
- Further these single janapadas were surrounded by other Janapada states and this naturally demanded for a demarcated territory which eventually became a **well-defined cluster of states**.
- **Strong military leadership** became instrumental in establishing the states of Janapada and such successful military leaders proved more stronger and powerful than the elected representatives of the Jana, the Samiti of the Jana was **replaced with Sabha which was an assembly of citizens working under its own right and not under any authority**.



## Various Dignitaries of Janapadas

Mahabharata describes elaborately the virtues of an ideal ruler - kind-hearted, intelligent, self-controlled, full of piety, good-looking, of proper aim and rich in faithful friends. Several dignitaries were instrumental in running the administration. They aided and advised the King and looked out for his moral and material well-being and discharged the functions of the state:

1. **Purohita** - an indispensable companion of the king and occupied the highest rank among the officers of the state by virtue. The sole duty of the Purohita was to guide the King in whichever way was asked of him in that hour. He was to be proficient in Vedas, spiritual as well as temporal matters. The welfare of the King depended on him and he was to strive for the victory of his King.
2. **Yuvaraja or Royal Prince** - He is expected to possess all of the virtues as that of a king, an able kingsman, generally the eldest son of the King was preferred. Although the exact functions of the royal prince are unknown, it appears the princehood is a period of apprenticeship which offers numerous chances to the prince to be well-versed in the affairs of the state and government.




## Various Dignitaries of Janapadas



**3. Ministers** - They were expected to carry out the administration of the Janapada and advise the King on related matters. The number changed from state to state although it is preferred the number be fixed according to the requirements of the state. The qualities and functions of Ministers is elaborated in Ramayana, few of which are - tactful, true to his words, having a smiling face, always truthful, capable of knowing the secrets of others, adept in the art of governance, just, well known in foreign lands, etc. Constitutionally the Janapada king was bound to act on the advise and cooperation of the ministers, a point on which the Dharma Sutras, Dharma Shastras and the political treaties are unanimous.

**4. Senapati** - occupies the ministry of the Army or the minister of armed forces. On the occasion of appointing a senapati, his age, prowess, learning and general consent of the fighters in his favour would be taken into consideration. This is a position of honor but a rank below ministers.



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## Political Organisational Setup of Janapadas In Vedic Era

### 1. Parliament

The Ganas (leaders) had a parliament or a public assembly known as Sabha or Santhagara, where matters of law, administration and public importance were discussed.

### 2. Assembly hall


The Ganas had a common mote-hall known as Santhagara where the sittings of the Parliament used to be held.

### 3. Officers of the assembly

- a. **Asanaprajnapaka** - Officer in charge of seating the members of the assembly, appointed by the Parliament.
- b. **Gana Puraka** - Officer in charge of completing the quorum of the sitting of the assembly. It was obligatory for the assembly to be complete regarding the presence of the scheduled minimum number of members. Under the rules, any business transacted in the absence of the quorum was deemed to be invalid and inoperative.

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c. **Salakagrahaka** - Officer in charge of taking the votes of members in case of division or non-adoption of a resolution unanimously. The tickets used were coloured and he had to explain the significance of the colour to the members and take their votes either openly or secretly depending on the occasion. In the Chullavagu three modes of taking the modes are mentioned: **1. Gulhakam (secret method) 2. Sakanna-Jappakam (whispering method) and 3. Vivatakam (open method).**

d. **Sabhapala** - Officer charged with the duties of conveying the sittings and presiding over them without whom the sessions would be unorganized and chaotic. The presence of this officer in all meetings is necessary due to rival political parties having difference of opinions and sharply divided outcomes.

e. **Clerks of the House** - Officers in charge of taking records of the resolutions and speeches of the house. The title Of Maharaja attached to the recorders of the Sabha is a definite recognition of the importance of their counterparts in the assemblies of the Ganas.

## Proceedings in the Parliament

1. **Taking seats** - The Sabha was equipped with proper seats for the members to sit and take part in deliberation. The emergent sittings were called by the beating of the drum or ringing of the tocsin.
2. **Janapati** - The proceedings were initiated with a motion termed Janapati, the exact wordings of which ran as follows in case of the religious samgha.

“Let the venerable Samgha hear me”, “If the time seem meet to the Samgha do.....”

3. **Pratijna** - Janapati is followed by the resolution where the matter is first placed before a house in a form to be adopted. The members of the house who approved of the resolution were to keep silent and those against it were required to speak. If discussions ensued and opinions were divided, then the method of collecting votes and ascertaining the majority opinion was resorted to. If the resolution did not stir any dissent, it was read thrice and then taken to be carried out and approved by the house.



## Proceedings in the Parliament

4. **Readings** - Two modes were prevalent with regards to moving of the resolution and their carriage in the assemblies. There was a system of 'Natti-Dutiya' and "Natti-Chatuttha", which included one motion of the Natti and reading of the Pratijna once and thrice accordingly. This was strictly followed and any discrepancy on this count might invalidate the act.

5. **Quorum** - the person in charge of the quorum may be called the whip of the house in modern terminologies. An act performed by the house without the required quorum made it invalid and inoperative. The Mahavagga mentions 5 kinds of Snaghas - Vagga of four, five, ten, twenty, more than twenty members. In any case the minimum number of quorum is required to validate the acts performed by the respective Sanghas.



## Proceedings in the Parliament

6. **Discussion and voting in the assembly** - when the assembly failed to adopt a resolution unanimously, the discussions on it ensued and could lead to either of the two following stages: either the speeches made in connection with the resolution made in both the sides might have the effect of conciliation and the resolution be carried out unanimously *or* the discussion may fail to render the house and might arise division of opinion on the resolution, when the method of ascertaining the views of the majority of the members of the house is resorted to. The voting on such occasions was taken through the help of coloured tickets called Salakas, the process of collecting tickets is called Salakagrahana. An official possessing requisite qualifications takes the vote in any of the prescribed manners suiting to the occasion. It is open to him to resort either to open or secret methods of collecting votes. After collecting votes the opinion of the majority would be ascertained and the resolution considered to be carried or lost in the light of the majority-view.



## Proceedings in the Parliament

**7. Quorum and the votes of absentees** - In the case of absenteeism for any reason, the house attached importance to the views of the absentee members in principle, though in practise the cognisance of such votes depended on the decision of the members present and voting in the house. The practise implies the forehand notice of thr resolution to all members of the house, as without such information, no opinion could be expressed. It moreover emphasis es the zealous regard for the rights of the members, where they could not be debarred from expressing their opinion on the resolution because of a natural disability.

**8. Deligation commitees** - in case of knots or pointless speeches in the house, the 'Udvahikas' or the delegation committee would settle the matters so referred to them. This procedure of settlement was known as 'Sammukha vinaya' or proceedings-in-presence. In principle, the delegates were taken to represent the interest of both parties and safeguard them.




9. **Parliamentary Misdemeanor** - the members of the house were expected to abide by the code of discipline and revolting against it was considered hurting the rights of the other members to which they would be put through a procedure of censure. It was a settled practise of the parliamentary assemblies that a matter once disposed of in accordance with legal procedure could not be re-opened. The act of reopening a settled problem amounted to an offence called 'pachittiya' and deserved the censure of the house.

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## **Anubhava Mantapa:** The Hindu Parliament of Lingayat community

- One of the most popular Hindu Parliaments in the 12th century which regularly meets is the Anubhava Mantapa. Anubhava Mantapa is a Hindu Parliament most famously known for functioning in the capacity of a Chit Sabha (House of Consciousness) for the Lingayat Community.
- Anubhava Mantapa was established in the 12th century, in the Hindu Kingdom of the Western Chalukya Empire. It is the oldest surviving religious Parliament in the world, and the oldest surviving Hindu Parliament.
- The literal meaning of Anubhava Mantapa is House of Self-experiences.

- Advocating a life of generosity and kindness.



## Objectives of the Anubhava Mantapa **Kanaka Sabha - House of Prosperity**

- The founder father of Anubhava Mantapa Basavanna envisioned building an ideal society where all individuals must express equal opportunities for religious, spiritual and vocational pursuits in life.
- In Hinduism, catering to different pursuits of life, there are various types of currencies based on either gold, grain, merit (karma), etc.
- Basavanna developed two economic policies and currencies based on merit, and coined two words :
  - **Kayaka** - Where Work is equated to attainment of Kailasa.
  - **Dasoha** - Where Charity is equated to attainment of Kailasa.





## Objectives of the Anubhava Mantapa **Kanaka Sabha - House of Prosperity**

- **Kayaka** - Work is equated a step towards attainment of Kailasa. Kayaka means working with the a feeling that you are involved in the advancement of the civilisation and thereby strengthening the Dharma - the Dharma of the mankind.
- It is said, the **net effect of Kayaka in practise was that the granaries of the King Bijjala started overflowing** with surplus.
- **Dasoha** - Charity is equated a step towards attainment of Kailasa. Dasoha is the concept of returning back to the society. Even today Lingayat / Veerashaiva Maths that are spread across Karnataka, provide food and education for free to the needy, irrespective of their social, or religious identities.



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## A Global House of Consciousness

- Although situated in the far Southern region of India, Anubhava Mantapa attracted hundreds of saints and spiritual aspirants from all over the continent who included among others its chief, Allama Prabhu, Siddarama, Madivala Machayya, Ambigara Chowdaiah and others from different parts of Karnataka; Urilingadeva from Maharashtra; Bahurupi Chowdaiah, Sakalesa Madarasa from Andhra; Adaiah, Soddala Bacarasa from Saurashtra (Gujarat).
- **Hindu spiritual leaders such as Moligeya Marayya and his wife Mahadevamma came from Kashmir, which is about 2500 Kilometers far from Bidar Anubhava Mandapa.**

## How members of the House addressed each other

- The members were in general called Sharanas, which means people who sought refuge of spiritual principles.
- Sharanas, irrespective of their social background or upbringing were addressed respectfully as family members as 'Aiyya (Sir), Appa (father), Akka (elder sister), Avva, Kakkayya, Haralayya, Madayya, Muktayakka, Sankavve - reverential epithets, which he gave to every member of the society, including women.
- This led to a beautiful ambience for spiritual inquiry in various fields of life.

## **Hindu Feminism in Anubhava Mantapa**

- The Anubhava Mantapa was highly progressive for its time and several women participated in the proceedings of the Anubhava Mantapa. There were several women members in the Anubhava Mantapa, to name a few Akkamahadevi, Gangambike, Nilambike, Muktayakka, Kadire Remmevve, Kottanad Somavva, Sule Sankavve.
- The ratio of women members in Anubhava Mantapa was far more than what is observed today almost 900 years later.

## Akka Mahadevi : Introduced Hindu Feminism in Anubhava Mantapa



A true ascetic, Akka Mahadevi is said to have refused to wear any clothing—a common practice among male ascetics, but shocking for a woman. Legend has it that due to her true love and devotion with Paramashiva her whole body was protected by hair.

- Akka (elder sister) Mahadevi (birth name unknown) was originally married to the Governor of Udathadi, named Kaushika. Her condition for marriage was that Kaushika should not demand or disturb her while she was absorbed in her devotion to Lord Paramashiva. However, Kaushika broke this promise. Akka Mahadevi decided to leave the palace.
- While she was leaving Kaushika provoked her asking why she was taking along with her all the expensive jewellery and silken robes. In response, it is said she dropped everything including her clothes and **walked 500 Kilometers to the Anubhava Mantapa.**
- It is said, the entire House was shocked to see a women enter without covering herself. The members asked her why she came to the House of Consciousness.
- Akka answered all their questions, which led the house to realize that she was a spiritually evolved soul and was thus given place and hence respectfully addressed as Akka (elder sister).

## Detractors and Conspirators




**Basaveshwara - founder of the Anubhava Mantapa**

- The revolutionary thoughts and ideas of the Anubhava Mantapa created a sensation among the anti-Hindu conspirators.
- The detractors organised themselves to collapse the Parliament.
- They framed many allegations, concocted tales about the founder Basaveshwara and tried to defame him in King Bijjala's court.
- Basaveshwara was accused of misappropriation of the State funds.
- Basaveshwara was impeccably honest and integrity to him was central to his existence.
- He placed the entire accounts of the State before the King, who was infuriated by the false allegations made against Basavanna by his detractors and warned them of serious consequences for making false and baseless allegations.

## Persecution by anti-Hindu conspirators

- Two Sharanas, (members of the House), Haralayya and Madhuvarsa from different castes had married.
- This gave an opportunity to the anti-Hindu detractors.
- They made several defamatory false allegations against the Basaveshwara and the House.
- The King asked Basaveshwara to exile himself.
- After Basaveshwara's exile, the anti-Hindu forces mercilessly persecuted Haralayya and Madhuvarsa.
- They were chained to the legs of an elephant, which dragged them to their death.
- This was also the beginning of the end of the Anubhava Mantapa.
- The members of the house were infuriated with this atrocity. Taking advantage of the chaos, the opponents of the king and the anti-Hindu forces conspire against the king and killed him.




**Persecution of the Members of the House of Anubhava Mantapa by Anti-Hindu forces**

- Till today there is no parallel example in any part of the world of the extent of inclusiveness that the House exercised.








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## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Environment

- "Planet earth cannot sustain, cannot afford any more meat-based lifestyle."

- **10 billion animals are slaughtered for human consumption each year.**
- It takes 7 Kg of grain feed to produce 1 Kg of beef, 4 Kg of grain to produce 1 Kg of pork, 2 Kg of feed to produce 1 Kg of fish-meat. Given this, if the entire planet turned vegetarian, it would drastically increase the available grain for the entire planet.



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
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## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Environment

- According to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), chemical and animal waste runoff from factory farms are responsible for more than 173,000 miles of polluted rivers and streams. Runoff from farmlands is one of the greatest threats to water quality today. Agricultural activities that cause pollution include confined animal facilities, plowing, pesticide spraying, irrigation, fertilizing, and harvesting.
- "Neither nature nor your body is made to sustain a non-vegetarian lifestyle."

- Vegetarian diets are **more healthy**.
- Vegetarian diets contribute to **preventing**, treating, or reversing heart disease and reducing the **risk of cancer**.




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## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Environment

- A low-fat vegetarian diet **stops the progression of coronary artery disease** or prevents it entirely. Cardiovascular disease kills one million Americans annually and is the leading cause of death in the United States. As per studies, the **mortality rate for cardiovascular disease is lower in vegetarians than in nonvegetarians**. A vegetarian diet is inherently healthful because vegetarians consume less animal fat and cholesterol (vegans consume no animal fat or cholesterol) and instead consume more fiber and more antioxidant-rich produce.
- **Increased life expectancy:** According to a 30-year study done on 600 centenarians of Okinawa, their secret: a low-calorie diet of unrefined complex carbohydrates, fiber-rich fruits and vegetables, and soy. (A centenarian is a person aged above a hundred years.)



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## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Environment

- Vegetarian diets being low in saturated fats **help in maintaining lower body weight**. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and a division of the CDC, the National Center for Health Statistics, 64 percent of adults and 15 percent of children aged 6 to 19 are overweight and are at risk of weight-related ailments including heart disease, stroke, and diabetes. A study conducted from 1986 to 1992 by Dean Ornish, MD, president, and director of the Preventive Medicine Research Institute in Sausalito, California, found that overweight people who followed a low-fat, vegetarian diet lost an average of 24 pounds in the first year and kept off that weight 5 years later. They lost weight without counting calories or carbs and without measuring portions or feeling hungry.



## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Environment

- Vegetarian diets which are low in saturated fat **keeps us more energetic**. Too much fat in the bloodstream causes arteries to not open properly and thus reduces oxygen to muscles.
- Vegetarian diets contain more fiber, which reduces instances of constipation, hemorrhoids, and diverticulitis.
- Organic vegetarian diets reduce the intake of toxins. The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), estimates that nearly 95 percent of the pesticide residue in the typical American diet comes from meat, fish, and dairy products. Fish, in particular, contain carcinogens (PCBs, DDT) and heavy metals (mercury, arsenic, lead, cadmium) that can't be removed through cooking or freezing.



## Positive Impact of Vegetarianism on Economy

Shifting to a vegetarian diet will increase the grain production and thus potential export of a country. For instance, about 70 percent of all grain produced in the United States is fed to animals raised for slaughter. The 7 billion livestock animals in the United States consume five times as much grain as is consumed directly by the American population. If all the grain currently fed to livestock were consumed directly by people, the number of people who could be fed would be nearly 800 million, says David Pimentel, professor of ecology at Cornell University. If the grain were exported, it would boost the US trade balance by \$80 billion a year.



The Bhagwatam (17.15.5,7,8) says, "In the shradh feast pure vegetarian food, after offering to God, should be given to brahmins. It satisfies the Pitra (ancestral) gods forever (5). It is Dharma (even for Kshatriya) that in Shradha feast he should neither offer meat nor he himself should eat meat. Only vegetarian food must be offered because the meat is obtained by killing an animal (7). This is the best Dharma to observe for everyone that one should not hurt other beings even in his thoughts (8)."

The meat-eater who kills an animal in the name of Vedic Yagya or tells that it is a requirement of the Yagya is a sinner and he will go to hell (verse 43). The one who brings an animal to be killed, the one who buys the animal to be killed, the one who kills the animal, and the one who sells, buys, cooks and eats the meat are all sinners (verse 45)."






- **Out of the people who voted :**
  - 46.7% were born and practicing Hindus,
  - 34.9% were born but not practicing Hindus,
  - 14.1% were practicing but not born Hindus, and
  - 4.3% were non-Hindus.
- **The voting options were :**
  - **Option 1:** Non-vegetarian food to be completely stopped!
  - **Option 2:** Non-vegetarian food should be allowed regularly.
  - **Option 3:** Non-vegetarian food should be allowed ritualistically.
- **Results**
  - Overwhelmingly, 74.2 % of people voted for non-veg food to be completely stopped!
  - 14.4 % voted that it should be allowed regularly.
  - 11.3% voted that it should be allowed ritualistically




## Total Hindu Votes on Vegetarianism Cumulative Chart ( 2004 to 2018 )





## Significance of Ishwaratattva in KAILASA's Governance

**Ishwara Tattva - Paramashiva is real, He is the ultimate Lord in every being**

**The principle of Ishwara Tattva implies**

- **Divinity Of Cosmos**
- Leadership (Ishawaratva) of the Divinity of Cosmos
- The principle of divine lordship (Ishawara) exists in everything that exists in the cosmos.

A being that is established in Ishwara Tattva realizes the principles of ultimate divinity and lordship of the cosmos. 




## Mrigendra Agama on Ishvara Tattva



The eight Vidyasvaras are – Ananta, Sukshma, Sivottama, Ekanetra, Ekarudra, Trimurti, Srikantha, and Sikhandi. These Vidyasvaras are the Lords wielding their authority over the Rajarajesvaras such as Satarudras and others, Rajesvaras such as Indra and others, and Isvaras such as Mandali and others. These Vidyasvaras are associated with only one bondage known as “Adhikara Mala’(a lingering taint of Anava mala) and so they are slightly inferior to the state of Paramesvara. According to the gradation of the mature state of ‘Adhikara Mala’, **these eight Vidyasvaras are installed in a graded state in the Isvara Tattva. Even though they are endowed with the power of all-knowing(Sarvjantva) and such other significant powers, each one of them is having a different state of maturation of Adhikara Mala.** From Anantesvara to Sikhandi, each one is superior to the succeeding one, in the installed order. Even the Mantras who are in the region below the plane of Vidyasvaras are with graded maturation and perfection. These Mantras, being commissioned and directed by Sivasakti who distinctly manifests Herself within the Mantresvaras, bestow grace upon the souls (Sadhakas performing the mantra Japa) existing in the realm of impure Maya, according to their fitness and perfection.

### (7) Effect of meditation on homicide and crime rate

In 1960, Maharishi Mahesh Yogi predicted that one percent of a population practicing the TM technique would produce measurable improvements in the quality of life for the whole population. This phenomenon was first documented in scientific research in 1976 when it was found that when 1% of a community practiced Transcendental Meditation, the crime rate was reduced by 16% on average. At this time, the phenomenon was named the Maharishi Effect. The meaning of this term was later extended to cover the wider influence generated by group practice of the TM-Sidhi program. 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

### (8) Hindus are the happiest community in the UK

The average happiness rating was 7.38 out of 10. Hindu community scored 7.57 for happiness, well above the average and also highest among all communities. Christians stood second with a score of 7.47. Sikhs and Buddhists scored 7.45 and 7.41 respectively; Jews scored 7.37, which was just below the average. Muslims were the unhappiest people among major religious communities. Their happiness rating was 7.33. People who chose 'any other religion' scored 7.26. People who belonged to 'no religion' were the unhappiest people in the UK. They scored just 7.22. The study also measured life satisfaction, worthwhileness, and anxiety. The Average rating for life satisfaction, worthwhile, and anxiety was 7.5, 7.8, and 2.9 respectively. The average anxiety rating was highest in the age group 45 to 59 years. The lowest average ratings for life satisfaction and happiness were also recorded by the same age group. The highest average levels of personal wellbeing were shown by people in the age group 65 to 79.



## Principle of Advaita (Oneness)


**Advaita Satya (the truth of oneness) implies that no individual being has a separate individual existence, but is a part of the Whole.** The feeling of being separate is declared to be Maya (illusion and ignorance). The realization of the principle of Oneness (Advaita) is the realization of the divine nature of the Self.

The principle of Oneness, when applied, has a profound effect on the lives of individuals and entire nations alike. Some of the pursuits of modern-day democracies find their mention in the Preamble of their respective Constitutions, to name a few - FRATERNITY, EQUALITY, etc. Although these principles are not equivalent to the principle of Advaita, any nation designed with the principle of Advaita would also as a natural consequence bring a sense of FRATERNITY and EQUALITY to the society and to the nation. Advaita (Oneness) is the underlying hidden key principle, which forms the basis of a successful human society, a successful nation, and a successful peaceful planet.



## Principle of Advaita (Oneness)

When individual citizens are established in the principle of Advaita (Oneness), there is no individual "me" separate from a larger "we", which essentially means that each individual feels responsible for the good of the entire nation. Likewise, when an entire nation is established in the principle of Oneness, there is no "we" separate from a larger "all of us". Consequently, there is no word for "alien" in Sanskrit - the official language of KAILASA. The concept of some person or being to be an alien is unknown in the Hindu Cosmic Constitution. This has been described as "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" in the Maha Upanishad (a part of VedaAgamas - the Hindu Cosmic Constitution), which means - **The World is One Family**. The principle of Advaita (Oneness) is the backbone principle which has created several generations of enlightened, peaceful, loving Hindu citizens of KAILASA.


## Upanishads - the roots of the most beautiful democratic structure



The Cosmic Constitution has two parts - Shrutis and Smritis. The Shrutis (the heard) contain the core principles which are non-amendable sections of the Cosmic Constitution. The Smritis are amendable and thus are evolved as per the needs of the people. This way Cosmic Constitution is both stable and upgradable. It is stable as the core truths being preserved from adulteration and dilution. It is upgradable by allowing changes to be made as per the needs of the time.


For any person, born in any nation, the laws of the nation and its principles are the accepted truths just by the virtue of the person being born in that country - this is modern-day democracy. Indeed, the constitutions of modern-day democracies are amendable, however, for all practical purposes in most modern-day democracies, the principles and pursuits of the nations are first accepted by default and only later understood and if at all required and possible amended.

However, in Hindu democracy, the citizens are encouraged to discover the principles of democracy by pure questioning and investigation. Thus Hindus of KAILASA are not born into Hindu democracy, they discover their Hindu democracy. This is a unique beautiful aspect of Hindu democracy.




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## Upanishads - the roots of the most beautiful democratic structure



For discovering the ultimate principle of life the Cosmic Constitution insists on the inquiry into the nature of the Self (Jeeva), the world (Jagat), and the ultimate lord (Ishawara). The Upanishads (major chapters of the Vedas, which are the non-amendable parts of the Cosmic Constitution) dedicate a majority of verses to inquiry into the truth rather than giving any opinion or answers about the nature of the truth. The core non-amendable verses are pure science - thought currents designed to enable investigation into the truth, rather than a book of law which only tells the right or wrong. From these pure thought currents of investigation, any law or principle may be created. Thus Upanishads are the source of several philosophies, doctrines, theologies, religions, and systems of law. However, at the same time, Upanishads themselves are neither philosophies, doctrines, theologies, religions, or a mere system of law. Upanishads are the pure thought currents to enable investigation of the truth and have no known equivalent.

So, what Upanishads want to say about good and bad, right and wrong, high and low, in these last three verses Upanishads are declaring beautifully the whole science of life, almost all the questions of good and bad, right, wrong, who is higher, who is lower, why somebody is enjoying, somebody is suffering. Everything is clarified, understand? Upanishads don't answer question by question. They just bombard the questioner! Upanishads, if they answer hundred of your questions, they will make you question millions of your answers! You questioning many of your answers using these sutras (verses) is what I call "internalizing", "manana"; means, you questioning many of your answers using the truths of Upanishads, revelations of Upanishads.


## Scientific Principles of Investigation into the truth as per the Cosmic Constitution



The Cosmic Constitution lays down certain scientific principles and methods for investigating the truth. According to this, the completeness of knowledge is investigated using Anumana (inferences) and Pramanas (evidence). As per Hinduism, for any system to be considered fit for everyone (and not just a few), it is tested at four levels - (1) Sakshi Pramas, (2) Atma Pramana, (3) Apta Pramana, and (4) Shashtra Pramana.

1. **Sakshi Pramas** - Authentication of the truth by the self
2. **Atma Pramana** - Authentication of the truth by the Guru (Hindu spiritual leader and guide) of the self
3. **Apta Pramana** - Authentication of the truth by great and well-known incarnations of the past.
4. **Shashtra Pramana** - Authentication of the truth by Hindu scriptural records that predate all known world history.

Only when a given subject of investigation survives the acid-wash test of all these four criteria it is accepted. Shastras (Scriptures) are a compilation of such principles that have withstood trillions of such acid-wash tests done by billions of Hindu citizens and leaders of the past and present. These acid-wash tests are done even today, by Hindu citizens. Thus, Shastras (Scriptures) are considered Supreme in Hinduism not just by default, but by a rigorous investigation.



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## Scientific Principles of Investigation into the truth as per the Cosmic Constitution

The Parliament Houses of Hindu Democracies are made for this very purpose of investigation. More than being interested in amending the Hindu Constitution, the pursuit of a Hindu Democracy is to discover the truth taking inspiration from the core scriptures and applying them to practical life for the welfare and enlightenment of all. For the past 26 years, this exercise of voting on Hindu principles has been happening in KAILASA by the grace of Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism Jagat Guru Mahasannidhanam His Divine Holiness Bhagavan Sri Nithyananda Paramashivam. ## Ahimsa - Non-violence - The ultimate principle

The principle of Ahimsa understood as Non-violence, abstention from cruelty, non-injury; has been declared as the highest principle in the Cosmic Constitution. Ahimsa in light of the principle of Advaita (Oneness) also implies self-defense (non-injury to oneself) as much as non-injury to others. Ahimsa also means to choose the path of minimum violence when left with no other option - which means for example - it is better to perform a small surgery on the body rather than amputating a part of the body or leaving the entire body to die.

Even death is ok but don't ever become violent. Nonviolence is the best strategy even in the face of death because if you adopt violence, you will go down into more and more deluded consciousness and suffer. If you adopt nonviolence, even if you die you will raise into higher and higher consciousness. Your ability to take birth as you want, your ability to enjoy life as you want, by the pure observance and cognising “Ahimsa Paramo Dharmaha”. When you cognise nonviolence is the ultimate dharma, you have so many wonderful powers manifesting in you.



## Ahimsa - Non-violence - The ultimate principle

You will master the higher states and space of existence because nonviolence will bring tremendous strength and fearlessness. Every time that happens you will become fearless. Non-violent response to every crisis removes the fear and strengthens your cognition and ability to cognise powerful cognitions.


### Even in War - Hindu Kingdoms followed principles of compassion

On several occasions in Hindu history, Hindu Kings were forced into war. But even in war Hindu citizens, and kings of KAILASA followed humanitarian principles. For this reason, many Hindu Kings did not kill invaders even after defeating them in war. Citizens of KAILASA always trusted the fundamental goodness of human beings. Several invaders took advantage of this goodness and kept waging repeated attacks. Ultimately these Hindu Kingdoms of KAILASA were destroyed in two millennia-long Hindu Holocaust.

The Hindu Code of Conduct for War had several humanitarian aspects such as prohibited the killing of civilians and prohibited the burning of crops, etc. These principles were followed by Hindu nations as late as 3000 BCE. However, for most of the present world, these humanitarian laws of war are very recent, such as :

## Hindu Humanitarian War Protocols of 3000 BCE compared to Contemporary International Humanitarian war protocols

To put things into perspective, we may say that even way back in 3162 BCE, Hindu nations followed principles of war which were much more considerate and humanitarian than the International Humanitarian laws and protocols of the present age such as - 1977 GC-P1, 1907 Hague Convention, 1948 UN-Res.-260(III), 1998 Rome Statute, 2005 ICRC Customary Rules of International Humanitarian Law, etc.

Some examples of Hindu Humanitarian laws of war which have no equivalent in the present day :

- Fighting must begin no earlier than sunrise and end exactly at sunset.
- No more than one warrior may attack a single warrior.
- No warrior may kill or injure an unarmed warrior.
- No warrior may kill or injure an unconscious warrior.
- No warrior may kill or injure a warrior whose back is turned away.
- No warrior may strike an animal not considered a direct threat.

## Ahimsa (Non-violence)



*“When Ahimsa is seen as a life strategy, you will win in life. Ahimsa leads to invincibility, to the Ajeyam state. It will give that Atma Bala - strength of the soul, Consciousness. Again and again, many are trying to harass me through social media saying, ‘you are teaching constant nonviolence, ahimsa, peace. Don't you see you are making Hindus weaker?’ if they understand me, they will see I am trying to make them really stronger! Strength is the intelligence of the existing. It is not violence, terrorism, or conversion. Neither by conversion nor by terrorism any religion is going to survive in the future. The future of religion is not going to be decided by their capacity for conversion or terrorism. That period is over. The next generation is not interested in conversion or terrorism. It is interested in living life and life positivity. The biggest mistake Hindus did in the name of nonviolence and Tyagais, they withdrew from life. A real Tyagi will be so alive, active, and enriching the whole world for Tyaga. Real nonviolence is not only you will be living the nonviolence, through all possible infrastructure like media and education system, you will be enriching the whole world actively with nonviolence and Tyaga. “*

## Ahimsa (Non-violence)



*“This is the survival need of the world, of humanity. I appreciate Hindus holding on to the principles of ahimsa and Tyaga, but I want you to understand where you missed. Human beings think only aggression is activity and either conversion or terrorism is a religious activity, no! Actively enriching is the real spirituality-based religious activity. Hinduism is a spirituality-based, enlightenment-based tradition. Hindus should have reached this to the world through the international media, to tell the right narrative of Hinduism, how it is ahimsa, Tyaga based. Hindus should have reached out to the united nations and to the whole world.*

### How Deities were protected during invasions during the last millennia



The renunciate, selfless monks of KAILASA tried their best to protect KAILASA's national enlightenment heritage from these attacks.



The universe by its very nature is Guru, it has Guru Tattva, the principle of guiding into it. With compassion the universe keeps guiding us in form of life experiences, this is the most basic form of expression of Guru Tattva. Suffering, sorrow, joy, are means and modes by which Guru Tattva (which exists in the universe) guides us. The most ultimate manifestation of the Gurutattva is the physical human embodied Guru Himself - incarnation of Paramashiva.

Surely for all these begins, there is no truth higher than the Guru. A seeker should offer a seat, a bed, clothing, ornaments, a vehicle, and other things that will please the Guru.







## Total Hindu Votes that accept Divinity and Supremacy of Guru : Cumulative Charts ( 2004 to 2018 )


